DANCE WORLD ACADEMY DRESS CODE - BODYWEAR

BODYWEAR FOR PRE-SCHOOL, COMBO I, COMBO II, TAP/JAZZ COMBO AND ALL TAP & JAZZ CLASSES

GIRLS

- -No jewelry and/or dangling earrings can be worn.
- -Any color leotards and tights. Leotards and booty shorts may be worn. Please, no rips or runs in tights.
- -NO sweatshirts and cover-ups (unless permitted for Hip Hop). T-Shirts must be form fitting.
 -Hair must be pulled up or back away from the face. PLEASE LONG HAIR MUST BE IN A PONY TAIL OR SUITABLY WORN SO AS NOT TO GET IN THE STUDENT'S WAY.

In levels I and above, leggings and Jazz pants are permitted (these are normally **spandex** and come in long, Capri length and booty shorts) and must be form fitted to the body. Sweatpants **are not** permitted. Jazz pants, leggings and booty shorts **must** be worn with a leotard or sports bra.

BOYS

- -Athletic shorts and t-shirts
- -Sweatpants and t-shirts (teachers need to see the line of the body) No baggy clothes please!

BALLET UNIFORMS

All dancers in Ballet 1 through Advanced Ballet (not Preschool, Combo 1 and Combo 2 Students) will be required to wear a black sleeveless or black short sleeved leotard (any style) for ballet class. Leotard can not have skirt attached. This can most likely be purchased at the dancewear store where you buy your dance shoes. It is important for your teacher to see the lines of your neck and shoulder.

Biketards or Booty shorts may NOT be worn for ballet class. Usually we order ballet uniforms through our school in different colors but we will keep things simple this year and go back to our color coded leotards next season.

Students need to wear PINK tights (not flesh toned) and pink ballet slippers.

Boys may wear shorts and a t-shirt (preferably black shorts and white t-shirts).

Students may take Pointe once they reach Grade 4 Royal Academy of Dance Program. Please do not buy pointe shoes if you are a beginner pointe student. Your teacher will provide information on this.

Hair ABSOLUTELY MUST BE IN A BUN FOR BALLET CLASS.
